

## **WORSHIP**

Contact, Sarah W, the Director of Liturgy at 251-8115.

Altar Server - 4<sup>th</sup> grade and older to serve at Mass.

Eucharistic Minister - Minister Communion at a weekend liturgy.

Eucharistic Minister - Minister Communion to Homebound or Good Shepherd Nursing Home residents .

Lector - Read during the Liturgy of the Word at a weekend liturgy.

Interpreter - Mass is interpreted for the hearing impaired: the 1st through 3rd Sunday of each month, the 8:00 a.m.; the 2nd Sunday of each month, the 5:00 p.m.; the 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of each month, the 10:00 a.m.

Sacristan - Help prepare and set up vessels before and after a weekend liturgy.

Ushers - Assist at a weekend liturgy by welcoming people and taking up collection.

Lay Presider - Lead Communion services and assist at wake services.

Leader for Liturgy of the Word for Children - Lead children, ages 6 - 9, during the Liturgy of the Word for Children during Advent and Lent at the 10:00 am liturgy.

Art and Environment Committee - Assist in planning and implementing church environment for liturgical seasons.

Linen Care - Wash and iron altar linens and towels.

Sanctuary Care - Maintain: candles, holy water fonts; clean: sanctuary, confessionals, crying room, restrooms.

Seamstress - Keep chasubles, albs, altar cloths, etc. in good repair

## **MUSIC**

Adult Choir - Senior high or adults sing at the Sunday 8:00 am liturgy, rehearsal weekly on Wednesday.

Cantor - Vocalist with a strong vocal background to sing responsorial psalm and lead assembly in song at weekend liturgies on a scheduled basis.

Praise Choir - Junior, Senior high, or adults sing at one or two liturgies per month, rehearsal TBA; instrumentalists also involved in this group.

Resurrection Choir - Sing for parish funerals.

Organist/Pianist - Play/ Accompany for weekend liturgies on a scheduled basis.

Instrumentalist - Play your particular instrument at a liturgy when called upon.
