

MINISTRY & LIFE PERSPECTIVES



From Safari....

We're in Ordinary Time, just the day-today, run-of-the-mill, practice-of-faith time, which, the church tells us, is the perfect time for transformation. I share this story by Melissa Musick Nussbaum, as it gives insight into the importance and role of the eucharist

in our lives and an example of transformation.

I didn't hurry to the church for Margaret's funeral. She was, after all, 86 years old, and had been ill for several years. There would be plenty of parking. My concern was that there weren't going to be enough people to fill the front pews.

Turns out, I had to park on a side street. The lot was full. So was the church. When Nick, her husband of 60 years, rose to speak before the Mass began, his words of welcome and remembrance made it clear why so many people had gathered to give thanks for Margaret's life.

Nick began with gratitude — for the members of the parish and its priests, for bridge playing friends, for neighbors, for family, for the nurses, therapists, care-givers and doctors who had been with them in Margaret's illness and death. He said what they had learned is that, "If you want to die in peace, and in hope, if you want to die well, you must have a community."

He said it was fitting we were all gathered at Mass to bid her farewell, because Mass, the community that gathers before the altar, was at the center of their life together. He said they had come to understand Mass as "an event, but also a process." In their marriage they had come to Mass "burdened, distressed, empty and worn out." Sometimes they came angry with one another. He spoke of it as the place they came each Sunday "to remember and be reset." Sunday mornings in church "became a time to remember what we believed in, remember our commitments, remember the promises we made to each other, remember who we wanted to be for our children, our co-workers and our neighbors."

This is what we learned, Sunday by Sunday: "Margaret belonged to me and I belonged to Margaret and together we came to belong to God." He recalled Margaret saying to him, just weeks before she died that "God speaks to each of us through the other." He said, "I knew God most truly through her," the woman he described as "my profoundest friend."

Nick spoke of Margaret's many gifts, but said he had the most joy watching her as a mother. He recalled her two "hard and fast" rules for their five kids. The first rule: No bad language. He said that was because she believed cruel and hateful and blasphemous language demeaned the speaker and the hearer. He said Margaret told them,

"There's a little bit of Jesus in every person you meet. Your job is to find it." The second rule: Go to Mass. He said they came to Mass as a family in all sorts of places and in all sorts of weather and in all sorts of anger and confusion. He said they went in sorrow and left consoled. They went angry and left forgiving. Went anxious and left in peace. (Celebration, January 2017, p. 12, Kansas City, MO)

As Nick and Margaret came to discover, the Eucharist (Mass) is a place to come each week to remember and be reset. If we are open to Christ, what he touches will be transformed. As Nick confirms -- they went in sorrow and left consoled; went angry and left forgiving; went anxious and left in peace.

In what ways does your experience of the Eucharist (Mass) mirror that of Nick and Margaret, in what ways is it different?


