#### MINISTRY & LIFE PERSPECTIVES



From Safari......

Welcome to Ordinary Time. Before we fully enter into Ordinary Time we celebrate today the Solemnity of the Blessed Trinity. Much has been written on the Trinity, a reality which is difficult to

fully grasp. While we will never fully understand the mystery of the Trinity, the most important take away is that we are called to enter into the life of the Trinity. At our baptism we were brought into the community of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Each time we sign ourselves with the cross, we reaffirm our relationship with the Trinity.

What does it mean that we enter into the life of the Trinity? John Foley offers this insight about the Trinity,

First, long ago human beings learned that there is only one God, who found "delight in the human race" Think of the many, many stories in the First Testament about God pursuing us, his labor to make a loving and holy covenant with us. "I will be your God and you will be my people," he said. Like a marriage agreement. Did this work? Well, not really. God became, by turns, angry, hurt, delighted, spurned, glorified, ignored, praised and rejected. Yet he kept coming back and back to renew the covenant, since God's love is steadfast.

Second, we found out that God's nature had always possessed another component. God had not been alone or lonely, as in a desert. His very nature had always been to relate to others, to "pour himself forth," and to receive back. This giving and receiving is the "Second Person," or the "Word." This Word was made flesh. We saw him. Jesus laughed and cried and preached and turned over tables and cured folks, and was loyal to his people even to the end. "Everything that the Father has is mine," he said. That's how we knew that Jesus was The Word and that the Word was God.

Gradually there came a third revelation about the Trinity. Jesus hints about it: "I have much more to tell you, but you cannot bear it now." In other words, our small souls could never ever open to the great God—unless an actual presence of God gentled itself down and began to dwell within us. Do you get the two-way logic? Everything the Father has and is belongs to the Word; everything that the Word has and is belongs to the Father. This mutuality is a third "part" of God. It is

the Spirit. It tells us who the Christ (God) is, and it bestows us (and the whole earth) back upon the Father, closing the circle. What aliveness, what keenness there is in God: speaking to us, reaching out, flowing forth, and then receiving back. God is like liquid motion, like a dynamism in which everything is changing always, yet it remains always the same because it is rooted in love—because it is love. We are invited into that circle of love.





#### CHOIR DIRECTOR OPENING

St. Francis Xavier is a vibrant Catholic parish with 1850 households. The choir director works with the adult choir of our parish, with 25 current members. The director selects music for the choir, rehearses with them bi-weekly and directs the choir every other Sunday from September through Pentecost. \*Advent, Christmas, Lent and Triduum seasons will require extra liturgies.
