Reminder of Cemetery Rate Changes As of January 1, 2024, the following rates will apply:

- -\$350 for a parishioner gravesite (an increase of \$50)
- \$1500 plus a perpetual care fee of \$250 for a non-parishioner gravesite (no change)
- \$200 for a parishioner urn (increase of \$50)
- \$600 for a non-parishioner urn (increase of \$100)

The fees for opening and closing graves, monuments, and related costs are not part of these rates, and remain the responsibility of the family. Those who wish to purchase burial rights for plots in our cemetery before the increases go into effect may do so at any time before January 1, 2024.




