POSITION: VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL HELPER

Overview and Service Impact: Being a VBS helper is deeply connected to the gifts we are given at Baptism and that are strengthened at Confirmation. It is worth taking the time to discern if God is calling you to serve in this way. VBS helpers will perform one of a number of duties using materials provided and nurturing the faith of participants. Possible duties include being an activity station leader, activity station helper, crew leader, or crew helper. VBS helpers should be at least 12 years old. They will walk with the groups, helping them to come to know their Catholic faith and love God in a deeper way.

Key Responsibilities:

- Attend the scheduled meetings/training sessions
- Become familiar with the resources available to them
- Commit to preparing well and carefully for each session before arriving at VBS, being sure to arrive early enough to set up and check supplies. Request additional materials at least three days in advance as needed including but not limited to copies and other handouts
- Model God's grace in relationships within the VBS setting. Relate to the participants in a compassionate and respectful manner and foster a sense of security as well as a safe space with participants, making boundaries and guidelines for participation clear
- Handle classroom management with the support of the Director of Faith Formation, particularly for any issues that arise that they are unable to manage
- Be familiar with Diocesan Safe Environment policies and report any issues of safe environment, emergency medical needs or unsafe classroom behaviors to the Director of Faith Formation or the Pastor immediately
- Have fun and enjoy the growth in faith, fellowship and community that comes from being part of VBS!

Time Commitment: VBS helpers will be responsible for participating in five 2 to 3 hour sessions per summer as well as a 1 hour scheduled meeting/training session. They will also be responsible for at least 2 hours of prep for each of the sessions.

Qualifications/Requirements: VBS helpers should be practicing faith-filled and faithful Catholics willing to share the Gospel message with others in a VBS setting. They should have a good basic knowledge of their faith and be willing to grow in that knowledge through continuing education and spiritual opportunities as well as being willing to take direction and give direction when needed. They should model Christian values and be good with people as well as being organized, dependable, consistent and committed to their area of ministry. Safe environment training and background checks for the Diocese of St. Cloud must be completed and an initial discernment meeting with the Director of Faith Formation will be required.
