What is Peer Ministry?

Peer Ministry is a leadership program for High School students (grades 9 – 12) interested in learning, leading, serving and supporting their peers as disciples of Jesus Christ. Peer Ministers also help bring peers to an authentic encounter with Jesus through building relationships and building community. Peer Ministers must be open to growing in their faith, have a desire and openness to share that faith with others, be spiritually and emotionally healthy and be committed to a lifestyle that is pleasing to God.

What can you expect? Expect high standards, hard work, the support of a Christian community, spiritual development, the joy of serving others in a positive way, personal growth and a ton of fun.

What Do I Do?

1. Interview

All applicants will go through an interview process with the Director of Youth Ministry and an adult leader to determine if Peer Ministry is for you.

2. Plan

The Peer Ministry Team gathers on the second Wednesday of the month from either 6:30 – 8:00 PM OR 7:30 – 9:00 PM. Meetings are essential for planning Youth Group, practicing roles, and building community.

3. Lead

As a Peer Minister, you are a leader to the entire community of Sacred Heart, not just your peers. Peer Ministers will lead using their gifts / strengths in a variety of ways in the parish community (liturgy, festival, VBS, committees, social concerns, etc.) along with being responsible for 5th Grade Youth Night and the 9th Grade Retreat. Youth Ministry at Sacred Heart is ran and promoted by those on the Peer Ministry Team.

4. Retreat

One of the many benefits of being a Peer Minister is the opportunity for additional retreats (Summer / Winter). **It is our expectation that all Peer Ministers attend our Summer retreat (June 19 – 21).**

5. Review

All Peer Ministers will have a mid-year review to evaluate roles, check-in and continue to ensure we are going the right direction. These reviews will generally take place in January within your schedule.

What Will We Do for You?

1. Build Skills

As a member of the Peer Ministry Team, you will build skills / strengths that will aid you in many areas (school, work, sports, etc.) for the rest of your life. Throughout the year we work on communication, problem solving, and working together. Each Peer Minister will also take StrengthFinders upon joining the team.

2. Support

The Peer Ministry Team is designed so that each member can be a support for one another. You can expect a loving and caring environment with a pastoral approach to meet you where you are at.

3. References

The skills of a Peer Minister are ones that employers and colleges want. Take your role seriously, work hard and you are guaranteed a reference or letter of recommendation from one of our staff or adult leaders.
